ENTRIES CLOSE WEDNESDAY, April 26, 2006, 6:00 PM, PST, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

Exhibitors must obey (abide by) all regulations or requirements of the management of the facility owning the show site.

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies Of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by facsimile prior to close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

Declination of Entries. The Los Padres Collie Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Los Padres Collie Club or any official thereof.

All Entry Fees Are to be made payable to the **Los Padres Collie Club (LPCC)** and are to be mailed with entries to Judy Wilson, Show Secretary, P.O. Box 913, Rio Linda, CA 95673-0913. **FOREIGN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.** Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with any necessary tickets. Should such **ACKNOWLEDGMENT** not be received by the Exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the show secretary.

FACSIMILE MACHINE ENTRIES for this show will be accepted up to closing time. For VISA/MasterCard and American Express cardholders ONLY. You must include the front and back of the entry form. A \$3.00 charge will be added for each dog, each day. Be sure to include cardholder's name, address, card number and expiration date and signature. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added. Fax number (916) 923-6383. This is for facsimile machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in this show. Proof of transmission is not proof of a receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4). **Merchant name for VISA/Mastercard and American Express will be under Judy Wilson, Show Secretary.**

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show will be Open from 8:00 AM until 6:00 PM.

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged. The show-giving Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The Show Giving Club, The Show Secretary, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

No Dogs will be allowed in the Show Area except those regularly entered in the show. There will be **NO SPACE** for unentered dogs at this show.

All trophies, including cash prizes, MUST be claimed the day of the show—None will be mailed.

PLEASE NOTE:
No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

- * OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEAN-UP IN THE RELIEF AREA
- * NO STAKES MAY BE USED ON TENTS. IT IS SUGGESTED THAT SAND BAGS BE USED AS WEIGHTS.

All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must first be entered in one of the regular classes at this show. Mark "Sweepstakes" and the division in the additional class box of the entry form. A fee of \$13.00 must be sent with the regular entry fee to the Show Secretary. The Sweepstakes will be judged before the regular classes. Classes, with both Rough and Smooth competing in the same class, will be as follows:

PUPPY DOGS, 6 to 9 months PUPPY BITCHES, 6 to 9 months
 PUPPY DOGS, 9 to 12 months PUPPY BITCHES, 9 to 12 months
 DOGS, 12 to 18 months BITCHES, 12 to 18 months

The 1st place winners from each of the six classes shall compete for 1st Finalist. After the 1st Finalist is chosen, the dog that was 2nd to the 1st Finalist in that particular class is then eligible to compete with the remaining 1st place winners for the next placement. Only six dogs shall be in the ring to be judged for final placements at any one time, assuming all six classes have entries. Otherwise, it will be the number of dogs equal to the number of classes which have entries in the Sweepstakes. The dogs become eligible to be judged in a descending order from 1st place in each class. If, for any reason, the eligible dog is not available for judging, the next lower placement dog will be brought in for judging in its place.

DIVISION OF SWEEPSTAKE

Los Padres Collie Club will retain 25% of the total stake to defray expenses. The remainder of the Stake shall be divided as follows:

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
