PARKING

GENERAL PARKING -- General parking will be provided by ACE PARKING and will be available from 6AM Friday, Saturday and Sunday at \$10.00 a day. No setups or grooming allowed in the Day of Show Parking area. No entrance to the Overnight Parking Area is allowed. Stadium Security will be on duty. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!! NO RAINCHECKS & NO REFUNDS.**

OVERNIGHT PARKING -- There is limited spaces available. Fee for these spaces will be \$25.00 a night. A two-night minimum is required. Unsold spaces, if available will be sold at the gate for \$35.00 a night CASH ONLY. A two-night minimum is required. **POWER WILL BE PROVIDED AT THESE SHOWS FOR ADDITIONAL FEES.**

ALL PARKING WILL BE ON ASPHALT. BRING MATS FOR EXERCISE PENS, NO SAWDUST OR WOOD CHIPS ALLOWED! NO GENERATORS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10PM AND 6AM. STADIUM SECURITY WILL ENFORCE THEIR RULES. NO RAINCHECKS, NO REFUNDS.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Award of Merit

The Judge may select up to 10% of the superior quality specimens in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed from the intersex competition.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired at least two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get.
Brood Bitch Class - For bitches that have whelped at least two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce.
Brace Class - For two dogs of the same breed and variety, irrespective of sex, with identical ownership.
As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Classifications (continued)

Parade of Title Holders & Rescue Dogs -- All Golden Retrievers who are AKC Champions, Field Champions, have earned Obedience, Agility and/or Tracking titles, AKC Hunting Titles, WC or WCX or which have been taken as a part of the Club Rescue Program are eligible for the non-competitive Title Parade. The entry form must have "Title Parade" on it. Each entrant will receive a Rosette with the name of the dog imprinted on it. Please include with your entry a brief (fifty words or less) description of your dog's career or rescue.

SWEEPSTAKES

Open to any purebred Golden Retriever, six months of age and under eighteen months of age, and entered in any of the regular classes at the Specialty Show at which these Sweepstakes are held. Champions of Record are not eligible. Handlers: The dog must be handled by the owner, or co-owner, breeder or member of the immediate family of the owner, co-owner or breeder.

Classification

The following classes are divided by sex:

- Puppy 6 months/under 9 months
- Puppy 9 months/under 12 months
- 12 months/under 15 months
- 15 months/under 18 months

Veteran Sweepstakes

Open to any Golden Retriever eight (8) years of age and over that is individually registered with the American Kennel Club. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes. AKC Champions of Record and spayed or neutered Golden Retrievers ARE eligible.

Classification

The following classes are divided by sex:

- 8 years and under 10 years
- 10 years and under 12 years
- 12 years and over

Sweepstakes Prizes

After retaining 35% to defer expenses, the division of prize money in each class in Puppy and Veteran will be as follows:

1st Place - 25%, 2nd Place - 20%, 3rd Place - 10% and 4th Place - 10%

Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes will receive a Rosette.

In lieu of trophies the GRCSDC will make a donation to the Golden Retriever Foundation.

Junior Showmanship

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

SHOW REGULATIONS

Exhibitors must obey (abide by) all regulations or requirements of the management of the facility owning the show site.

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies Of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by facsimile prior to close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

Declination of Entries. The Golden Retriever Club of San Diego County, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Golden Retriever Club of San Diego County, Inc. or any official thereof.

All Entry Fees Are to be made payable to the **Golden Retriever Club of San Diego County, Inc. (GRCSDC)** and are to be mailed with entries to Judy Wilson, Show Secretary, 211 Wainwright Court, Sacramento, CA 95838-2941. **FOREIGN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.** Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with any necessary tickets. Should such ACKNOWLEDGMENT not be received by the Exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the show secretary.

FACSIMILE MACHINE ENTRIES for this show will be accepted up to closing time. For VISA/MasterCard and American Express cardholders ONLY. You must include the front and back of the entry form. A \$3.00 charge will be added for each dog, each day. Be sure to include cardholder's name, address, card number and expiration date and signature. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added. Fax number (916) 923-6383. This is for facsimile machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in this show. Proof of transmission is not proof of a receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4). **Merchant name for VISA/Mastercard and American Express will be under Judy Wilson, Show Secretary.**

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show will be Open from 7:00AM until 7:00PM.

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged. The show-giving Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The Show Giving Club, The Show Secretary, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

No Dogs will be allowed in the Show Area except those regularly entered in the show. There will be **NO SPACE** for unentered dogs at this show.

All trophies, including cash prizes, MUST be claimed the day of the show—None will be mailed.

PLEASE NOTE:

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

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Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, 5580 Centerview Dr., Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.

Junior Handler's must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC (919) 854-0195.

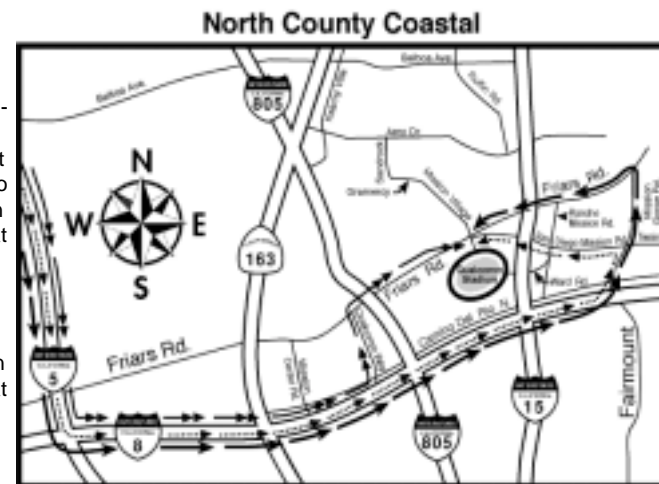
