SHOW REGULATIONS

Exhibitors must obey (abide by) all regulations or requirements of the management of the facility owning the show site.

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies Of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by facsimile prior to close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

Declination of Entries. The Giant Schnauzer Club of America may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Giant Schnauzer Club of America or any official thereof.

All Entry Fees are to be made payable to the Giant Schnauzer Club of America (GSCA) and are to be mailed with entries to Judy Wilson, Show Secretary, P.O. Box 913, Rio Linda, CA 95673-0913. FOREIGN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with any necessary tickets. Should such ACKNOWLEDGMENT not be received by the Exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the show secretary.

FACSIMILE MACHINE ENTRIES for this show will be accepted up to closing time. For VISA/MasterCard and American Express cardholders ONLY. You must include the front and back of the entry form. A \$3.00 charge will be added for each dog, each day. Be sure to include cardholder's name, address, card number and expiration date and signature. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added. Fax number (916) 923-6383. This is for facsimile machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in this show. Proof of transmission is not proof of a receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4). Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show will be Open from 8:00am to 6:00pm. .

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged. The show-giving Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The Show Giving Club, The Show Secretary, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

No Dogs will be allowed in the Show Area except those regularly entered in the show. There will be NO SPACE for unentered dogs at this show.

All trophies, including cash prizes, MUST be claimed the day of the show—None will be mailed.

PLEASE NOTE:

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

Note: 1st place winners of Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed IF undefeated in any other class at this show.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows provides that castrated males and spayed females may compete in Veteran Classes at independent specialties only.

Best of Breed Competition

Note: Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a *Championship* after the closing of entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the *Regular Classes* to the *Best of Breed or Variety Competition*, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the judging at this show (Chapter 11, Section 6, *AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows*).

Award(s) of Merit

The Judge may, at his/her discretion, recall into the ring UP TO FOUR dogs/bitches to receive Judge's Select Rosettes. These rosettes are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed or Variety.

6 - 8	Competing in Best of Breed	1 Award of Merit

Non-Regular Classes (Multiple Dog Entries)

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes is based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class: for stud dogs and at least two but no more than five of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Judging to be on the merits of the get. Get must be entered in another conformation class in this show.

Brood Bitch Class: same as for the stud dog except substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males and spayed females may be entered as Stud Dog and Brood Bitch in specialty shows.

Brace Class: effective 1/1/2005 -- for two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance. **Both dogs in the Brace class must have at least one common owner.** Dogs comprising a Brace unit must be named at the time of entry. Both dogs in the Brace class **MUST BE ENTERED** in another class at this show with the appropriate individual Entry Fee plus "Brace as a Unit" fee. Brace must be marked as an "Additional Class". If more than one Brace is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Brace as "Brace #1", "Brace #2, etc.
