*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that "Neutered dogs and spayed bitches would be allowed to compete in the Veterans classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed".

BEST OF VARIETY COMPETITION

Best of Variety/Best of Breed Competition - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Variety or Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Best in Puppy Classes - The First place puppy of each of the four Rough Puppy Classes (6-9 & 9-12 only) and the four Smooth Puppy Classes (6-9 & 9-12 only) are eligible to compete for this award. For the American Kennel Club definition of Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, American Bred and Open classes, see Chapter 3, "Rules Applying to Dog Shows".

The show grounds will be located at the South Grass Courtyard. The Hotel Claremont, (formerly the Ramada Inn & Tennis Club - Claremont) is located off the Interstate 10-San Bernadino Freeway. In Claremont take the Indian Hill Blvd. Exit (Exit 47) off of I-10 toward Claremont. Turn right onto S. Indian Hill Blvd. to the Claremont.

There is are several restaurants and a mini mart within walking distance of the hotel. If you plan on staying at the Hotel Claremont, please call the above number and make your reservations with Steve Mercado at extension #103. Advise him that you will be attending the Collie Shows. Room rates are \$99.00 plus tax per night and are for 1 or 2 beds in the room. There is also a \$99.00 refundable deposit required at check in for cash paying guests with dogs in their rooms. Please remember to use good common sense when keeping your dogs in the rooms.

REMEMBER...all dogs left unattended in the room *MUST* be crated. This is for your dog's safety and the staff's safety. Guests will be asked to leave the hotel if they cannot abide by this rule.

Important Parking Information

There is no charge for day of show parking. However, you will need to park on American Way (south side of site) only. Overnight parking on side streets is prohibited by Claremont City Ordinance. Do not park in the hotel lot if you are not a hotel guest.

Overnight RV Parking is limited to 10 spots. The rate is \$35.00 + tax per night. Check in at hotel front desk to register and pay. A parking permit will be issued and instructions where to park given. All vehicles must be fully self contained and include a fire extinguisher. **GENERATORS MAY ONLY BE OPERATED AFTER 9:00 AM AND MUST BE SHUT DOWN AT 8:30 PM.** This is a Claremont City Ordinance.

SHOW REGULATIONS

Exhibitors must obey (abide by) all regulations or requirements of the management of the facility owning the show site.

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies Of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by facsimile prior to close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

Declination of Entries. The San Gabriel Valley Collie Club (SGVCC), California Collie Clan (CCC) and South Bay Collie Fanciers (SBCF) may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the any of these clubs or any official thereof.

All Entry Fees are to be made payable to the **Judy Wilson, Show Secretary** and are to be mailed with entries to Judy Wilson, Show Secretary, P.O. Box 913, Rio Linda, CA 95673-0913. **FOREIGN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.** Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with any necessary tickets. Should such **ACKNOWLEDGMENT** not be received by the Exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the show secretary.

FACSIMILE MACHINE ENTRIES for this show will be accepted up to closing time. For VISA/MasterCard and American Express cardholders ONLY. You must include the front and back of the entry form. A \$3.00 charge will be added for each dog, each day. Be sure to include cardholder's name, address, card number and expiration date and signature. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added. Fax number (916) 923-6383. This is for facsimile machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in this show. Proof of transmission is not proof of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4). **Merchant name for VISA/Mastercard and American Express will be under Judy Wilson, Show Secretary. Online entries can be made at www.jwshows.com.**

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show will be Open from 8:00 AM until 6:00 PM.

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged. The show-giving Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The Show Giving Club, The Show Secretary, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child under the control of their parents or guardians.

No Dogs will be allowed in the Show Area except those regularly entered in the show. There will be **NO SPACE** for unentered dogs at this show.

All trophies, including cash prizes, MUST be claimed the day of the show—None will be mailed.

PLEASE NOTE:

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

All persons attending these shows hereby wave any claim for damages against SGVCC, CCC, or SBCF or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocations due to improper ventilation.

Junior Showmanship - Saturday & Sunday Only

Please Note: **ALL JUNIOR HANDLERS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE AN AKC JR. NUMBER.** Contact AKC, Show Records (919) 854-0195 for a Junior Handler number. Be sure to include all information required on both the front and back of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

he winner of the Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class. Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the breed classes at this show or entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season, or a veterinarian's excuse, may be replaced by another dog meeting the below ownership requirements. Such substitution must be required in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an Official AKC Form. All such requests must be made at least a half hour prior to the judging of any regular class at the show.

Each dog must be owned by the Junior Handler or the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. At a specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused under the Dog Show Rules for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Sweepstakes

Each Club will hold a Sweepstakes in conjunction with and on the day of their Specialty. Sweepstakes is open to all Collie puppies, Rough and Smooth, six months old up to eighteen months of age. The Sweepstakes is to be designated on the regular entry form by writing "sweepstakes" in the blank marked "additional classes". The fee for entering the sweepstakes is \$10.00 for each day entered and the puppy must also be entered and exhibited in one of the regular classes at the regular rate.

CLASSES & DISTRIBUTION OF THE SWEEPSTAKES MONEY

The clubs will retain 10% of the stake for expenses.

PUPPY DOG, 6 months under 9 months PUPPY BITCH, 6 months under 9 months
PUPPY DOG, 9 months under 12 months PUPPY BITCH, 9 months under 12 months
DOG, 12 months under 18 months BITCH, 12 months under 18 months

Competition for the finalist placements will start with the six class winners. As a finalist is chosen, the succeeding winning puppy from that puppy's class will be eligible to compete until the four finalist placements have been chosen. Thus the winners have defeated all the other puppies. The balance of the stake (after the club retains its 10%) will be divided for the Finalist Class as follows:

1st Finalist - 40%, 2nd Finalist - 30%, 3rd Finalist - 20%, 4th Finalist - 10%

SATURDAY -- CCC Only

If **fewer than ten** puppies are entered in the Sweepstakes for this show only, males and females six months and under eighteen months will be shown in two classes, one class for all dogs entered and one class for all bitches entered. The two class winners will then compete for 1st finalist. As 1st finalist is chosen, the succeeding winning puppy from that puppy's class will be eligible to compete until the four finalist placements have been chosen. Thus the winners have defeated all the other puppies.

The balance of the stake (after the club retains its 10%) will be divided for the Finalist Class as follows: 1st Place - 40%, 2nd Place - 30%, 3rd Place - 20%, 4th Place - 10%

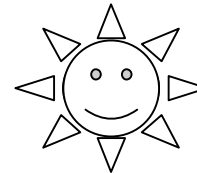
Important

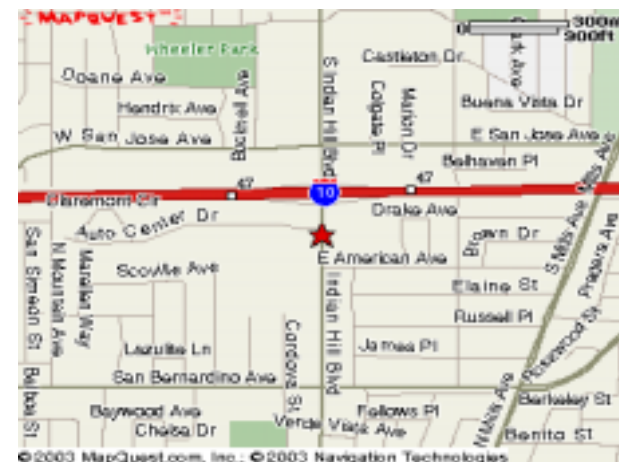
