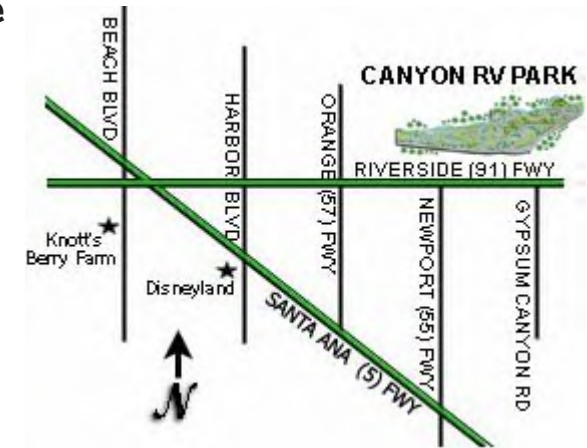

# Show Site

CANYON RV PARK at Featherly is located off Hwy 91 (Riverside Freeway) at the Gypsum Canyon Road Exit in Anaheim, California. ## Show Rules

**Declination of Entries.** the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Southern California (SSCSC) may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, vivaciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against either club or any official thereof.

**All Entry Fees** are to be made payable to Shetland Sheepdog Club of Southern California (SSCSC) and are to be mailed with entries to Judy Wilson, Show Secretary, 211 Wainwright Court, Sacramento, CA 95838-2941. **Entries will not be accepted without fees.** Acknowledgement of entries being received will be made if an e-mail address is given.

**Conditional, unsigned, or incomplete entries** or entries received without fees will not be accepted. Telephone or telegraph entries are not acceptable. All cancellations must be in writing and received by the Show Secretary before closing date. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$15.00 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check.

**No entry may be changed** or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. AKC Rule, Ch1 1, Sect 6.

**This show will be unbenched.** Exhibitors should bring their dogs to the show grounds one hour before the scheduled time of judging and may be excused after their class is judged, if they are not needed for further judging.

**If it is impossible to open or to complete the show** because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the club, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made.

**There will be NO exercise pens,** crates, tents, or grooming tables allowed within ten (15) feet of the judging ring. All grooming must be done in areas specified by the club and exhibitors are required to keep their areas clean. **There is no provision for unentered dogs** at the show. AKC Rule, Ch1 1, Sect 11

**Owners and owners' agents are** responsible for any errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations received after the close of entries, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or barred from competition by the action of the committee.

**Dogs must be ready for judging.** Owners or owners' agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring at the proper time. The Club is not obligated to provide any service for notifying exhibitors of judging.

**All trophies and/or rosettes and ribbons, including cash prizes, MUST be claimed the day of the show— None will be mailed.**

### Standard for local motel & Hotels for exhibitors

- 1) A display of temperament and poor judgment toward management and staff or other guest of that establishment.
- 2) excessive coat or debris left by bathing in the room
- 3) Damage to the room or facility by yourself or your dog.
- 4) Disturbing the guest of the motel or hotel by you or your dog.
- 5) Failure to secure your dog when your room is not attended by you or your staff, and excessive barking.
- 6) Stains on the furniture or carpeting from yourself or your dog. Removal of any property not belonging to you.

Misconduct at any facility is subject to the same disciplinary action as that of an incident occurring on the show grounds.

## Veteran Sweepstakes (Sunday Only)

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Shetland Sheepdogs who will be at least SEVEN years of age on the day of the show. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible to compete. Veterans may be champions or non-champions. Veteran Sweepstakes entries are not required to be entered in a regular class at this show, and will not compete against Best in Sweepstakes or Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes.

Classifications: The Veteran Sweepstakes judging shall be divided into six age classes, three for each sex, as named below and a class to determine Best Veteran In Sweepstakes, followed by a class to determine Runner-Up to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes.

- Dogs, 7 years and under 10 years.....Bitches 7 years and under 10 years
- Dogs, 10 years and under 12 years.....Bitches 10 years and under 12 years
- Dogs, 12 years and older.....Bitches 12 years and older

The Runner -Up is to be selected from the remaining 5 class winners plus the dog judged second to the previously picked Best in Sweepstakes.

Entries: Entry in the Veteran Sweepstakes shall be made on the official AKC entry form for the show. In the space titled "Additional Classes", write "Veteran Sweepstakes" followed by the name of the age class. The entry fee for the Sweepstakes shall be designated for additional

### Division of Sweeps Money

The stake shall consist of the total entry fees in the Sweepstakes, less 25% to help defray expenses of the club in conjunction with the Sweepstakes. The Sweepstakes shall be divided as follows 1st thru 4th in each of the six (6) classes, 3 Dogs and 3 Bitches. With Best In Sweepstakes and Runner Up to Best in Sweepstakes. The division of the money shall be as follows:

- a) 1st in each class will receive \$2.25 per dog entered in that class
- b) 2nd in each class will receive \$1.75 per dog entered in that class
- c) 3rd in each class will receive \$1.25 per dog entered in that class
- d) 4th in each class will receive \$1.00 per dog entered in that class
- e) Best in Sweeps receiving 70% of \$5.00 (\$3.50 cents) times total Dogs and Bitches entered in Sweepstakes
- f) Runner up to Best in Sweepstakes receiving 30% of \$5.00 (or \$1.50 cents) times total number of Dogs and Bitches entered in sweeps.

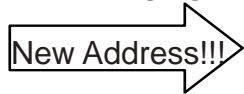

# Sweepstakes

## Sweepstakes Rules

The judging of the sweepstakes shall take place in conjunction with the Specialty Show of the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Southern California. The Sweepstakes shall be judge by a person selected by the Shetland Sheepdog Club of Southern California.

## Eligibility

The Sweepstakes shall be open to any Shetland Sheepdogs eligible & entered in one of the Regular Classes & whose age will be no less than six (6) months and not yet eighteen (18) months on the day of the show. The only exception to this rule is as follows: CHAMPIONS: No dog which has completed the requirements for a Championship prior to the date of judging shall compete in the judging of the Sweepstakes and any Sweepstakes entry fee submitted for such dog shall be refunded upon request of the dog's owner if such request is in the hands of the Show Secretary no later than the closing date of entries. For the purpose of these rules, the date of record for the Championship shall be the date of the Show at which the dog won its final points. Should it be found that an ineligible dog has received an award in the Sweepstakes, the person to whom such award was presented shall make restitution to the Club, and such award shall be deemed to have been won by the dog judged second to the dog declared ineligible. The prize money and other awards shall then be redistributed to conform to the rules regarding Division of Stake and Awards.

## Classes

The Sweepstakes judging shall be divided into six Age Classes, three for each sex, as named below, and class to determine Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes. a) Puppy Dogs, 6 to 9: For Dogs six months and under nine months of age. b) Puppy Dogs, 9 to 12: For Dogs nine months and under twelve months of age. c) Dogs, 12 to 18: For Dogs twelve months and under eighteen months of age. d) Puppy Bitches, 6 to 9: For Bitches six months and under nine months of age. e) Puppy Bitches, 9 to 12: For Bitches nine months and under twelve months of age. f) Bitches, 12 to 18: For Bitches twelve months and under eighteen months of age. g) Best in Sweepstakes: For the Winners of each of the above named classes. h) Runner Up to Best in Sweepstakes: For the Winners of the other five classes and the dog or bitch which placed second to Best in Sweepstakes.

## Entries

Entry in the Sweepstakes shall be made on the Official AKC Entry Form for the show. In the space titled "Additional Classes" the owner shall write "Sweepstakes" followed by the name of the Sweepstakes & Age Class. The entry fee for the Sweepstakes shall be the same as that for an additional class per dog which shall be in addition to the regular Show entry fee.

## Division of Sweeps Money

The stake shall consist of the total entry fees in the Sweepstakes, less 25% to help defray expenses of the club in conjunction with the Sweepstakes. The Sweepstakes shall be divided as follows 1st thru 4th in each of the six (6) classes, 3 Dogs and 3 Bitches. With Best In Sweepstakes and Runner Up to Best in Sweepstakes. The division of the money shall be as follows:

- 1st in each class will receive \$2.25 per dog entered in that class
- 2nd in each class will receive \$1.75 per dog entered in that class
- 3rd in each class will receive \$1.25 per dog entered in that class
- 4th in each class will receive \$1.00 per dog entered in that class
- Best in Sweeps receiving 70% of \$5.00 (\$3.50 cents) times total Dogs and Bitches entered in Sweepstakes
- Runner up to Best in Sweepstakes receiving 30% of \$5.00 (or \$1.50 cents) times total number of Dogs and Bitches entered in sweeps.

## Judging and Awards

Each Age Class shall be judged to Fourth Place, the number of dogs permitting. 1st place in each class shall be judged for the Best and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes. Each placement shall be awarded a prize ribbon, this shall be in addition to any stakes awarded as designated in the previous paragraph.

## AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of the bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

**I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**
