## SHOW REGULATIONS

**Exhibitors must obey (abide by) all regulations or requirements of the management of the facility owning the show site.**

**Telegraph**, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies Of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by facsimile prior to close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

**Declination of Entries.** The Portuguese Podengo Pequenos of America, Inc. (PPPA) may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Portuguese Podengo Pequenos of America, Inc. (PPPA) or any official thereof.

**All Entry Fees** are to be made payable to the Portuguese Podengo Pequenos of America, Inc. (PPPA) and are to be mailed with entries to Judy Wilson, Show Secretary, 209 Wainwright Ct., Sacramento, CA 95838-2941. **FOREIGN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.** Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with any necessary tickets. Should such **ACKNOWLEDGMENT** not be received by the Exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the show secretary.

**We are no longer accepting FACSIMILE MACHINE ENTRIES for shows. On-line entries can be made at [www.jwshows.com](http://www.jwshows.com). If you are unable to make online entries, you can contact an entry service for last minute entries. Several companies are listed on our web site at [www.jwshows.com](http://www.jwshows.com).**

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

**Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**The Show will be Open** from 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM on Friday.

**Consult Judging Program** for time of judging.

**Dogs May Arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

**Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is scheduled to be judged. The show-giving Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**The Show Giving Club, The Show Secretary**, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

**No Dogs will be allowed in the Show Area** except those regularly entered in the show. There will be **NO SPACE** for unentered dogs at this show.

**All trophies, including cash prizes, MUST be claimed the day of the show—None will be mailed.**

### PLEASE NOTE:

No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing or by telegram by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hours for entries, except that a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve-to-Eighteen Month Class at a show prior to the judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6.)

**All persons attending these shows hereby waive any claim for damages against Portuguese Podengo Pequenos of America, Inc. or the Ramada Reno Hotel & Casino, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from over-heating or suffocations due to improper ventilation.**

## IMPORTANT -- HOUSE KEEPING AT & AROUND HOTEL

To benefit the Specialty Event facilities and show committee we have adopted the following policy with board approval:

1. Any disregard for facility rules, destructive or disruptive actions, or disrespectful or abusive behavior may lead to Club sanctions and board hearings, which can result in fines or suspension from the Club.
2. All owners/exhibitors will be strictly held accountable for violations of this policy and will be required to pay for damages to hotel, beyond the "normal wear and tear".
3. The hotel and show committee realize that dog accidents can occur in guest rooms and no member will be sanctioned if an accident is reported immediately.
4. To comply with health code regulations, pets are not allowed in the pool area, fitness center or food and beverage outlets at any time during the stay.
5. The bathing and grooming of pets is not permitted in any hotel room.
6. The whelping of litters is not permitted in any hotel room.
7. **If a pet is left alone in the room it must be in a crate/kennel.** If housekeeping enters a room to find a loose pet, the room will not receive services for the day and be reported immediately to the hotel manager and show chair. Findings will be recorded.
8. Sheets of plastic must be laid under the crate(s).
9. Pets must be kept on a leash, at all times, in the interior public areas and the exterior grounds of the hotel property. When walking my pet, I agree to do so on the outer perimeter of the hotel grounds, away from the main lobby entrance and flower beds. All pet excrement will be picked up and put into appropriate containers.

**Additional Showsite Information** All Owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire hotel grounds are considered within the show grounds. You will be responsible for any damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same. Dogs may not be kept in rooms that registered "dogless". Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the show committee.

Dogs left in unattended vehicles in warm weather can suffer greatly from the heat and may die from heat prostration! ## Classifications (continued)

Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided if the criteria set forth in Chapter 16, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows is met.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Veteran Dog (7 to 9 yrs) ..... Veteran Bitch (7 to 9 yrs)

Veteran Dog (9+ yrs) ..... Veteran Bitch (9+ yrs)

(For Dogs/Bitches that are 7 years old and older)

(Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules states that neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veteran Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competition beyond Best of Breed)

### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

#### Award of Merit

After awarding Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex, the Judge may select, at his/her discretion, up to 10% of the entries in the Best of Breed competition as Awards of Merit.

Upon completion of Best of Breed Judging the first place winners of each of the puppy classes (6-9 & 9-12 in each division) will compete for Best Puppy in Show. The winners of each of the Bred By Exhibitor classes will compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show. And, the winners of each of the Veterans classes will compete for Best Veteran in Show.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Multiple Dog Entry)

As the decision of the judge in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged First in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

**Stud Dog Class** – For Stud Dogs and at least two and not more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered and shown in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class.

**Brood Bitch Class** – Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

(Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.)

**Brace Class** – For two dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one handler. Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner. Entrants need not be entered in any other class, but each must be on a separate entry form. Champions of record and altered dogs may be entered.

**AKC--National Owner-Handled Series**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed/Variety competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
  - If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
  - If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
  - If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
  - If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
  - If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winners are ineligible since it was defeated.
  - No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.
- \*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.

\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS.** For Boys & Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS.** For Boys & Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS.** For Boys & Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS.** For Boys & Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won Three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS.** For boys & girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten First Places with competition present in an Open Class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change the entry without charge the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants re-turn to the Open class to compete for the following year.

The winner of the Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the breed classes at this show or entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season, or a veterinarian's excuse, may be replaced by another dog meeting the ownership requirements. Such substitution must be required in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an Official AKC Form. All such requests must be made at least a half hour prior to the judging of any regular class at the show. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.

## PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in at least one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. All entries in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made, and on the same entry form. Champions of Record are eligible for the sweepstakes. The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all dogs and bitches under 18 months of age.

An entry/unit will consist of one child between the ages of 5 to 9 years. No Junior Showmanship number is required. A responsible parent/guardian/adult will be inside the ring with the unit. A second person may be required outside the ring depending on traffic. And, of course the PPP (at least 4 months of age). Only one unit enters the ring at a time. This is a non-competitive class.

The Judge will explain the process of showing the dog to the Junior and the responsible adult in the ring including breed specific presentation. Depending on the size of the dog and the child, the adult may be asked to lift a table breed on or off the table, or the Club may mandate that the adult should do it regardless. Neither the youngster nor the adult will be asked to show the bite.

The safety of the dog and the child inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes, the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so that both the child and adult will walk the dog together.
